• Break out room topic: Lead a conversation that helps to determine your different abilities and how that relates to your values as an open practitioner


Role 3 - Your vision from your vantage

 Break out room topic: Lead a conversation about what your vision might be for open education and your role in it.


Role 4 - What you bring to you open practice!
